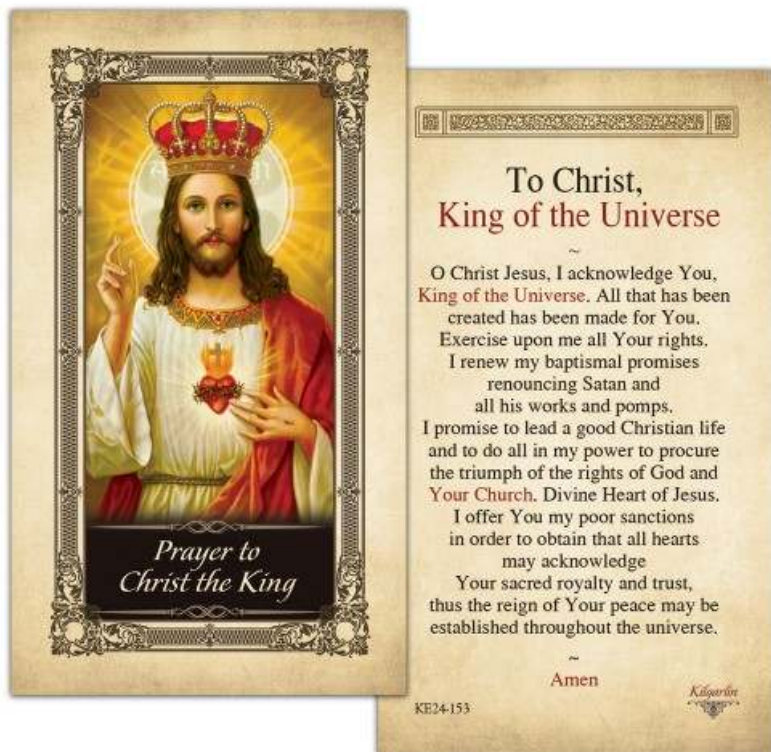

Prayer for Spiritual Communion

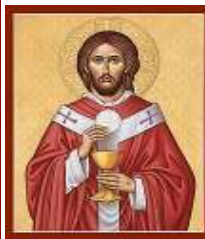

A Reading from the Letter of Saint Paul to the Romans 12:9-21

Let love be genuine; hate what is evil, hold fast to what is good; love one another with mutual affection; outdo one another in showing honor. Do not lag in zeal, be ardent in spirit, and serve the Lord. Rejoice in hope, be patient in suffering, persevere in prayer. Contribute to the needs of the saints; extend hospitality to strangers. Bless those who persecute you; bless and do not curse them. Rejoice with those who rejoice, weep with those who weep. Live in harmony with one another; do not be haughty, but associate with the lowly; do not claim to be wiser than you are. Do not repay anyone evil for evil, but take thought for what is noble in the sight of all. If it is possible, so far as it depends on you, live peaceably with all. Beloved, never avenge yourselves, but leave room for the wrath of God; for it is written, 'Vengeance is mine, I will repay, says the Lord.' No, 'if your enemies are hungry, feed them; if they are thirsty, give them something to drink; for by doing this you will heap burning coals on their heads.' Do not be overcome by evil, but overcome evil with good.

Gospel: Matthew 25:31-46

'When the Son of Man comes in his glory, and all the angels with him, then he will sit on the throne of his glory. All the nations will be gathered before him, and he will separate people one from another as a shepherd separates the sheep from the goats, and he will put the sheep at his right hand and the goats at the left. Then the king will say to those at his right hand, "Come, you that are blessed by my Father, inherit the kingdom prepared for you from the foundation of the world; for I was hungry and you gave me food, I was thirsty and you gave me something to drink, I was a stranger and you welcomed me, I was naked and you gave me clothing, I was sick and you took care of me, I was in prison and you visited me." Then the righteous will answer him, "Lord, when was it that we saw you hungry and gave you food, or thirsty and gave you something to drink? And when was it that we saw you a stranger and welcomed you, or naked and gave you clothing? And when was it that we saw you sick or in prison and visited you?" And the king will answer them, "Truly I tell you, just as you did it to one of the least of these who are members of my family, you did it to me." Then he will say to those at his left hand, "You that are accursed, depart from me into the eternal fire prepared for the devil and his angels; for I was hungry and you gave me no food, I was thirsty and you gave me nothing to drink, I was a stranger and you did not welcome me, naked and you did not give me clothing, sick and in prison and you did not visit me." Then they also will answer, "Lord, when was it that we saw you hungry or thirsty or a stranger or naked or sick or in prison, and did not take care of you?" Then he will answer them, "Truly I tell you, just as you did not do it to one of the least of these, you did not do it to me." And these will go away into eternal punishment, but the righteous into eternal life.'

يا إِخْوَتِي، لتكن محبتكم بلا رياء، تجتنبوا الشر ولازموا الخير. أحبوا بعضكم بعضا محبة أخوية، وبادروا بعضكم بعضا بالإكرام. كونوا في الاجتهاد غير متكاسلين وبالروح حارين، وللرب عابدين، وبالرجاء فرحين، وفي الضيق ثابتين، وعلى الصلاة مواظبين، وفي حاجات القديسين مشاركين، وإلى ضيافة الغرباء ساعين. باركوا الذين يضطهدونكم، باركوا ولا تلعنوا. إفرحوا مع الفرحين، وابكوا مع الباكين. كونوا متفقين بعضكم مع بعض، متواضعين لا متكبرين. لا تكونوا حكماء في عيون أنفسكم. ولا تبادلوا أحدا شرا بشرا، واعتنوا بعمل الخير أمام جميع الناس. سالموا جميع الناس إن أمكن، على قدر طاقتكم. لا تنتقموا لأنفسكم، أيها الأحباء، بل اتركوا مكانا لغضب الله، لأنه مكتوب: "لي الانتقام يقول الرب، وأنا أجازي". ولكن إن جاع عدوك فأطعمه، وإن عطش فاسقه، فإنك بفعلك هذا تترك على رأسه جمر نار. لا تدع الشر يغلبك، بل اغلب الشر بالخير.

ومتى جاء ابن الانسان في مجده، وجميع الملائكة معه، يجلس على عرش مجده. وتجمع لديه جميع الأمم، فيميز بعضهم من بعض كما يميز الراعي الخراف من الجداء، ويقيم الخراف عن يمينه والجداء عن شماله. حينئذ يقول الملك للذين عن يمينه: تعالوا يا مباركي أبي رثوا الملكوت المعد لكم منذ انشاء العالم، لأنني جعت فأطعمتموني وعطشت فسقيتموني، وكنت غريبا فأويتموني، وعريانا فكسوتموني، ومريضا فزرتموني، ومحبوسا فأتيتم إلي. حينئذ يجيبه الأبرار قائلين: يا رب، متى رأيناك جائعا فأطعمناك، أو عطشانا فسقيناك؟ ومتى رأيناك غريبا فأويناك، أو عريانا فكسوناك؟ ومتى رأيناك مريضا أو محبوسا فأتينا إليك؟ فيجيب الملك ويقول لهم: الحق أقول لكم: كل ما عملتموه لأحد إخوتي هؤلاء الصغار فلي عملتموه. ثم يقول للذين عن شماله: اذهبوا عني يا ملاعين إلى النار الأبدية المعدة لإبليس وجنوده، لأنني جعت فما أطعمتموني وعطشت فما سقيتموني. وكنت غريبا فما أويتموني وعريانا فما كسوتموني، وكنت مريضا ومحبوسا فما جئتم إلي. حينئذ يجيبه هؤلاء أيضا قائلين: يا رب، متى رأيناك جائعا أو عطشانا أو غريبا أو مريضا أو محبوسا وما خدمناك؟ حينئذ يجيبهم قائلا: الحق أقول لكم كل ما لم تعملوه لأحد هؤلاء الصغار فلي لم تعملوه. ويذهب هؤلاء إلى العذاب الأبدي، والأبرار إلى الحياة الأبدية.
